Applications

Those eligible to apply for scholarships are individuals working in a Delaware Montessori school and who plan to take their Montessori training at one of two AMS education centers in Delaware – M.I.T.E. (Montessori Institute for Teacher Education) or D.I.M.E. (Delaware Institute for Montessori Education.) Preference will be given to applicants who enroll for 3-6 training with second consideration for those who enroll in infant-toddler training.

Applications must be received by May 15, 2014.

Applicants are considered on the basis of financial need, a compelling personal statement, 2 letters of recommendation, official verification of acceptance into M.I.T.E. or D.I.M.E., and location of internship site. Recipients must agree to allow MTAD to publish that they have received an award from MTAD.

Funds

A maximum of two awards will be given during the 2014-2015 school year, with a maximum for each of \$2,000. The award will be sent directly to the training center to help reduce tuition costs for the intern. The intern must have an internship site.
